

Dimitrios Kalivas

Dimitrios Kalivas received the BS Degree in Electrical Engineering from the National Technical University of Athens in 1982, the MS Degree in Electrical Engineering from the North Carolina State University in 1983, and the Ph.D. Degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Southern California in 1989.

During 1982-1983 he was a teaching and research assistant in the Department of Electrical Engineering at North Carolina State University. From 1984 to 1989, he was a research assistant in the Signal and Image Institute at the University of Southern California. From 1989 to 1990, he was a lecturer in the Department of Electrical Engineering at the California State Polytechnic University, Pomona. During 1991-1992 he was a senior research scientist in the Department of Electrical Engineering at the National Technical University of Athens.

From 1993 to 1998, he was a project manager of communications and information technology projects in the Development Programmes Department at Intracom.

From 1998 to 2018 he was a professor in the Division of Communications and Networks, Department of Electronic Engineering at the Technological Educational Institute of Piraeus.

Since 2018 he has been a professor in the Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering at the University of West Attica.

His current research interests are in Design and Analysis of Communication Systems, Source Coding and Data Compression, Digital Image Processing and Analysis, Digital Video Processing and Compression

He has 35 publications in scientific magazines, conference proceedings, book chapters and technical reports. His work has been cited in more than 160 scientific publications by other authors.
